A huge congratulations to Oak Class on their *fantastic* end of year performance. The children sang beautifully, acted very well and made their class teacher and families very proud.



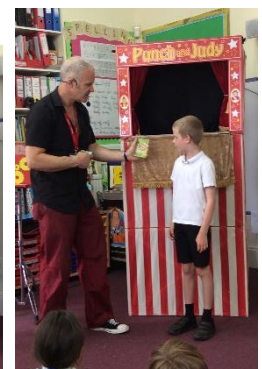
It was great to see the confidence, enthusiasm and positivity shine through this remarkable class. A big thumbs up and **WELL DONE** from us all. 😊
