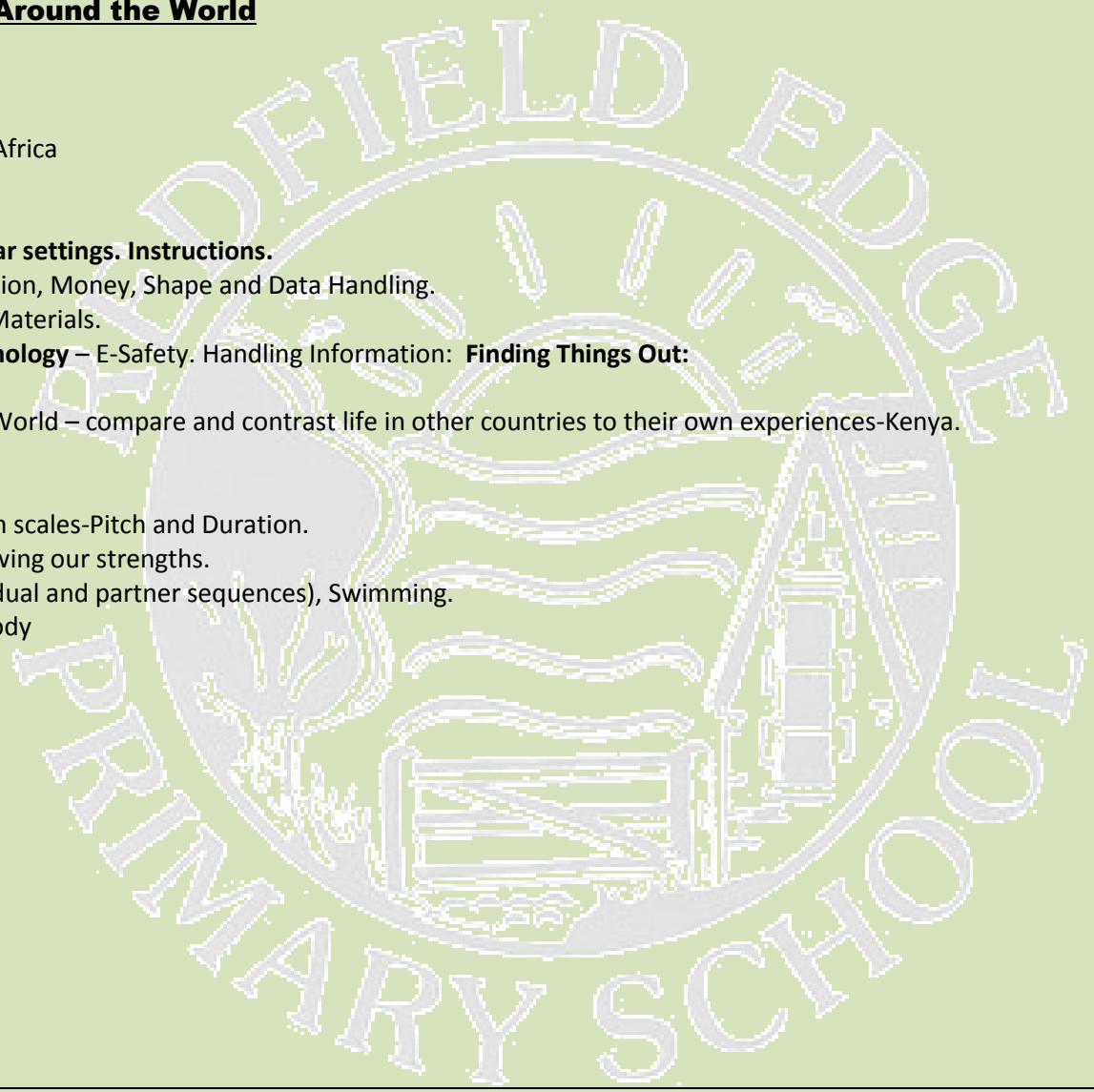

Art: Investigating pattern

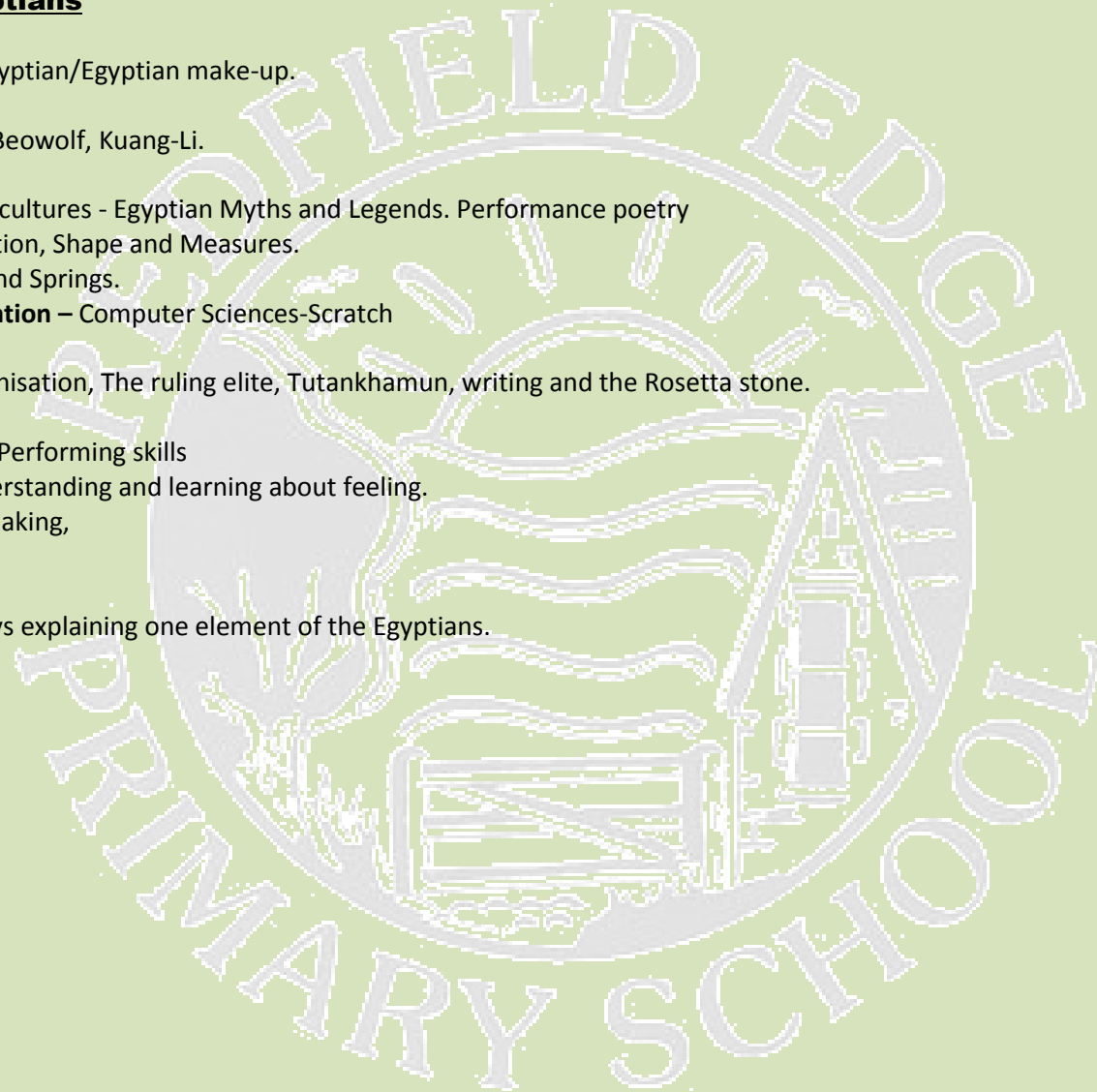

DT: Moving Monsters

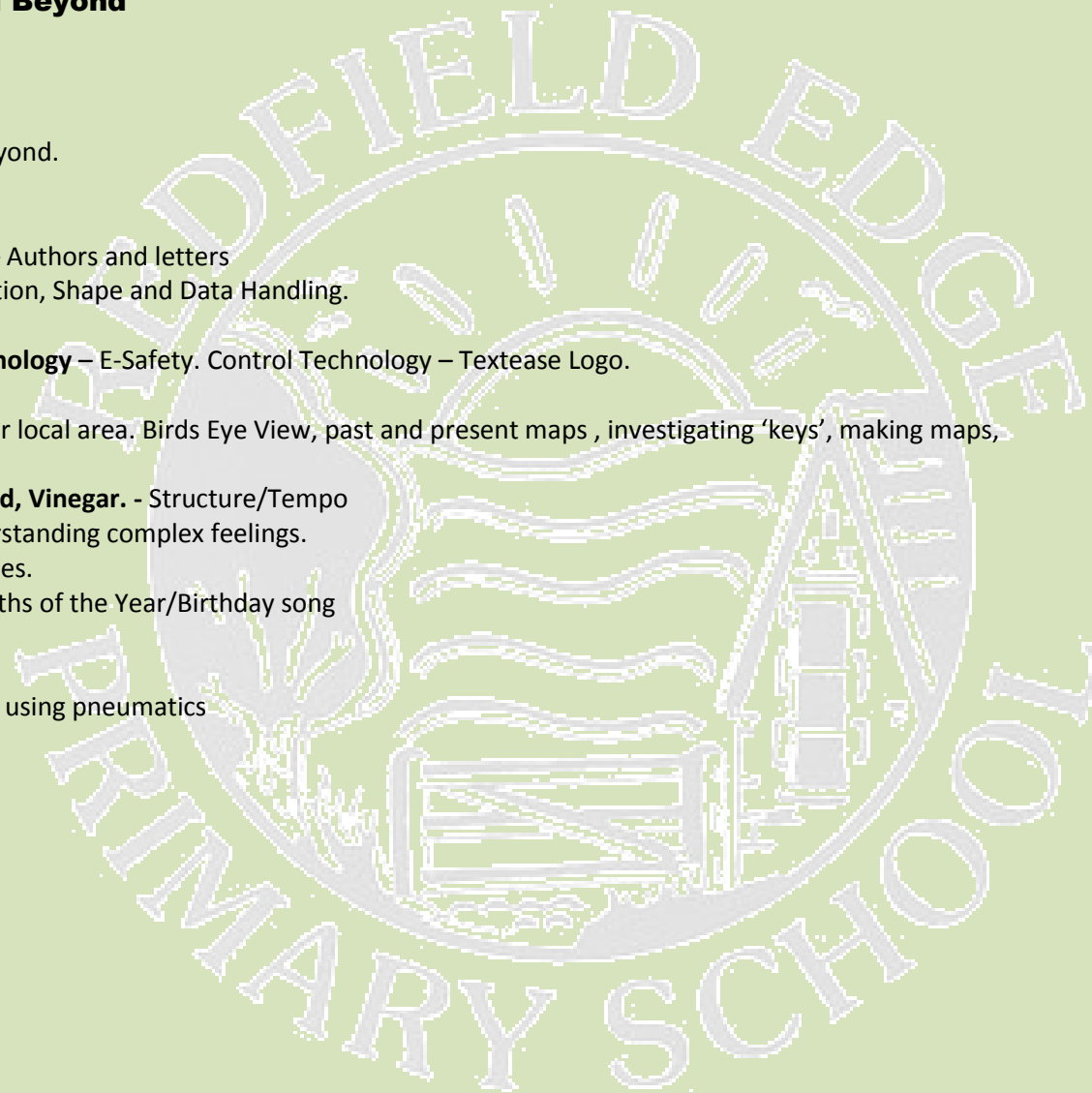
Music: Salt, Pepper, Mustard, Vinegar. - Structure/Tempo
