Communication and Language:

Following multi step instructions
Expressing views and opinions about characters in stories
Asking questions
Speaking in sentences, scientific vocabulary

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

Sharing, turn taking, playing cooperatively, conflict resolution, controlling feelings, compromising
Talking about opinions, likes, dislikes and listening to others, talking in class group
Transition into Year 1

Physical Development:

Control and coordination - yoga and ball games
Pencil grip and control - beginning to write on lines

Phase 3/4 phonics
Segmenting and blending words

Writing phonetically plausible sentences, using features of narrative
Reading and writing polysyllabic words

Counting in 1s, 2s, 10s, recognising numbers to 20 and beyond
Estimating, addition + subtraction
Measuring using standard and non-standard units
Time, 2D shape, 3D shape
