



## What are Pine Class learning in Term 1?



### English:

**Fiction-** writing descriptions of dragons, using adjectives and conjunctions to make sentences longer.

**Non-fiction-** instructions set in fantasy lands, time connectives, imperative verbs and adverbs.

**Non-fiction-** non-chronological reports about famous kings, queens and castles.

### History:

Children will be learning about kings, queens and castles by studying; events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally, the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements and significant historical events, people and places in their own locality.

Watercolour dragon eggs, Paul Klee "Castle and Sun", drawing famous monarchs, moving pictures (dragons and jousting knights)

**Gym/Games/Dance-** Master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities, participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending,

### R.E./P.S.H.E.

Harvest, settling in, what values would you have if you were king or queen?

### Maths:

**Number and Place Value-** count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in 10s from any number, forward and backward, recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (10s, 1s), identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line, compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs, read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words, use place value and number facts to solve problems.

**Addition and Subtraction-** solve problems with addition and subtraction, recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100, add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally, show that addition of 2 numbers can be done in any order (commutative) and subtraction of one number from another cannot.

Internet Safety- researching kings, queens and castles safely.
