Unsupervised Dogs

We have had a **concern** raised by a parent about a small number of dogs which are tied to our school fence, near the gates, where the children pass on their way in and out of school. The concern is mainly due to the fact that the dogs are left unsupervised and children are approaching the dogs attempting to touch them. It was also raised that many children may not like dogs and walking past them (whilst unsupervised) may cause upset. We would like to remind parents that dogs are not permitted on the school site and would strongly encourage parents not to leave their dog unsupervised at any point.

Parent Workshops

We have held a number of parent workshops over the past few weeks to offer support and information to our families on a range of topics.

Our **Healthy Cooking Workshop** took place on Wednesday for parents in Hazel and Pine Class. The session was led by the Community Learning Team with the assistance of Mrs Williams. The parents, with the help of their children, made a range of healthy snacks including pop-corn, apple crisps, fruit based oat snacks and fruit smoothies. The aim of the session was to give parents and pupils healthy alternatives. The parents took part in a food quiz and

learnt about what a healthy diet should look like. The parents were given handouts and recipes to try with their children at home. We hope those who attended found it useful.



As well as the **Community Learning Team**, Mrs Williams has also teamed up with our **School Health Nurse** and is running workshops on **mental health** and resilience. On Thursday, a group of parents attended the second of three sessions on Adverse Childhood Experiences. The sessions give parents an opportunity to reflect, learn and to ask questions about mental health. The final session is due to take place next week.

Mrs Williams has been very impressed with the interest and uptake for the recent workshops and so will be running them again at the beginning of the next academic year. Please keep an eye out for information to follow.
