Continent	One of the seven very large areas of the world.
Ocean	An ocean is a very big sea.
North America	One of the seven continents of the world.
South America	One of the seven continents of the world.
Europe	The continent in which we live.
Asia	One of the seven continents of the world.
Africa	One of the seven continents of the world.
Oceania	One of the seven continents of the world.
Antarctica	One of the seven continents which is cold.
Indian Ocean	One of the five oceans.
Pacific Ocean	One of the five oceans.
Arctic Ocean	One of the five oceans.
Atlantic Ocean	One of the five oceans.
Southern Ocean	One of the five oceans.
Equator	An imaginary line round the middle of the Earth.
