




## Writing


**Poetry** – Tudor Setting Poems

## Maths

**Multiplication and Division:** Multiply and divide (giving remainders as decimals) 4 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers and apply this to worded problems.  
**Position and Direction:** Describe positions on the full coordinate grid (all four quadrants). Draw and translate simple shapes on the coordinate plane, and reflect them in the axes.  
**Measurement:** Read, write and convert between standard units, converting measurements of length, mass, volume and time from a smaller unit of measure to a larger unit, and vice versa, using decimal notation to up to three decimal places.

## Topic (History/Geography)

**Chronology:** Understand key characteristic features of Tudor Britain and understand how that varied from our society today. Pupils show increasing depth of factual knowledge and understanding of aspects of Tudor Britain and the wider world.  
 Case Study: The Spanish Armada

**Historical enquiry and evidence:** Beginning to select and combine information from different sources. They know that some events, people and changes have been interpreted in different ways and suggest possible reasons for this. Using their knowledge and understanding, pupils are beginning to evaluate sources of information and identify those that are useful for particular tasks.

**Historical Viewpoint:** Some understanding that aspects of the past have been represented and interpreted in different ways.
