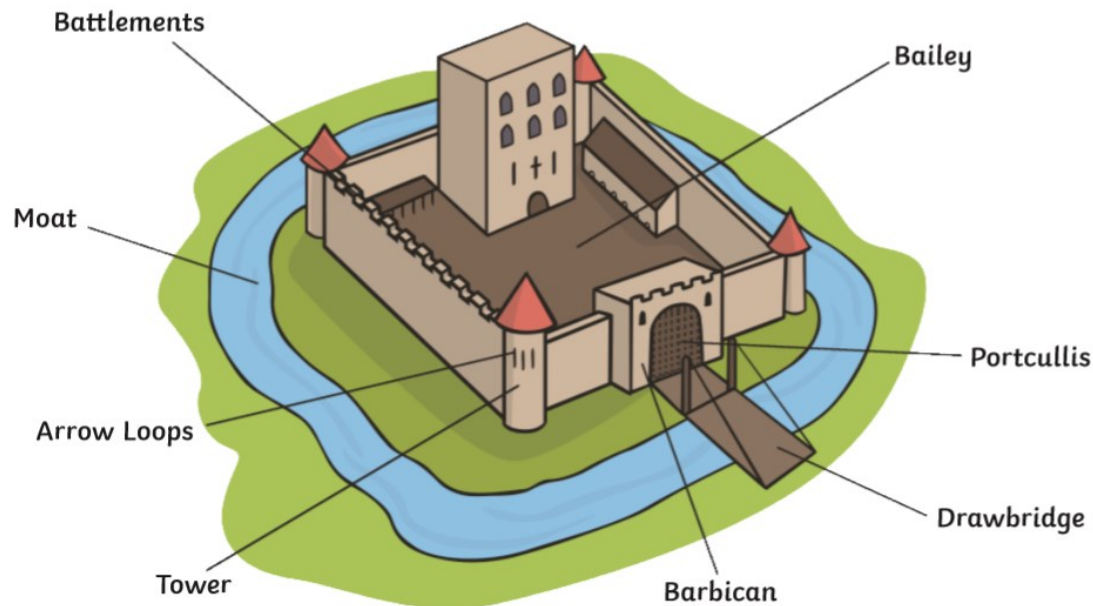


Definitions

monarch	An important person who has royal status like a king or queen.
medieval	Refers to the middle ages

peasant	A poor smallholder or farmer of low social status.
trebuchet	Similar to a catapult, used to hurl heavy stones to smash walls and castles..
ambush	A surprise attack by people lying in wait in concealed position.
armour	Metal layer worn to protect the body in battle.
disease	An illness cause by infection or failure of health.
stocks	Medieval device used for punishment involving public humiliation.
outlaw	A person who has broken the law.

<p>King Richard III</p> 	<p>Richard III became king after his brother King Edward IV died. Richard was only king for two years before he was killed in battle fighting against Henry Tutor.</p>
<p>Queen Elizabeth 1</p> 	<p>Queen Elizabeth I was the queen of England, Ireland and Wales from 1558 to 1603. Elizabeth did not get married so was the only ruler at the time, which was very unusual.</p>
<p>Queen Victoria</p> 	<p>Queen Victoria is one of the most famous monarchs in British history. She was so famous that a period of history was named after her: The Victorians.</p>
