English

Non-fiction- writing reports about minibeasts (the Spondolick Bug)

Science

Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive, identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other, identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including microhabitats, describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food.

Maths

Time- telling time to the quarter hour.

2D/3D shape- recognise 2D/3D shapes and their properties.

Revision of the four main operations- addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Computing

Data handling- use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content

Sorting information about minibeasts by branching and recording in block graphs.

Geography

Creating maps about our school grounds and using these to navigate around the area to search for minibeasts. (*Life skills)

Music

Children to recognise the musical symbols and create a short piece of music using a range of tuned and untuned instruments.
